

PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT MASTER'S DEGREE COMPLETION, MS

Campus: Online

The Master's in Physician Assistant Completion Program (MSPA) consists of 30 credits: four courses (12 credits) of study in a distance-learning format and 18 advanced placement credits. These courses will cover content areas not previously covered in bachelor of science degree programs which may now be incorporated in current MSPAS curriculum.

The program and distribution of credits and courses by term is depicted in the diagram below:
