

EDUCATIONAL STUDIES, MS

The MS in Educational Studies is intended for students seeking a deeper understanding of educational theories and practices without teacher certification. This program may appeal to those actively involved in social service agencies, such as program developers and administrators, individuals involved in publishing, and those with a general interest in education. It may also attract students interested in international education¹ and those planning to pursue a doctoral degree where an educationally related master's is a prerequisite. The courses identified in the Educational Studies degree are drawn from various programs within the School of Education, including Childhood and Adolescent Education, Early Childhood Education, Literacy Education, Special Education, TESOL, and Higher Education. This program requires meeting Pace University admissions policies for graduate studies. **NYSED requirements for teaching do not apply to this program.**
