- · Pass all prerequisite science courses (BIO 152, BIO 153, BIO 254, CHE 113) with a grade of B- or higher
- · Pass additional required courses (ENG 120, MAT 134, PSY 112) courses with a C+ or higher
- · Pass all nursing major courses (including approved nursing electives) with a B- or higher
- Maintain health compliance (health assessment, immunizations, CPR, criminal background check, drug screening, and additional requirements as advised) for clinical eligibility
