The five-year combined degree program offered by Women's and Gender Studies (WGS) and Public Administration (PAA) prepares students for feminist and social justice careers in nonprofit organizations as well as local, state and federal government agencies. Students will gain a uniquely marketable set of skills that will allow them to succeed in the ever-changing field of feminist or social justice oriented careers in nonprofit organizations.

This is an accelerated 5-year program of 147 credits, with 15 graduate credits taken in the undergraduate junior and senior year.
